Dear Minister,

I wish to inform you that as of yet my refuse collector has not provided me with a Brown bin facility, to allow me to separate my Food Waste from my domestic household waste. Consequently I am unable to avail of the significant financial savings available, to those who do have this service.

I commend your decision to increase landfill charges to €75 per tonne in July 2013, and fully support the new National Waste Policy announced on July 25th 2012, guaranteeing the roll out of the Bio - Brown bin for separation of domestic Food Waste albeit over a four year period. However the expectation that I should have to pay this increase if imposed on me by my refuse collector on Black Bin charges, while waiting delivery of my Brown bin service is not acceptable.

I would appreciate if you could give me an approximate date of when my area is expected to have a Brown Bin service, so that I too may be permitted to control my refuse charges by separating my Food Waste from my general waste.
